"This bi-annual trip exemplifies why we first made the decision to become doctors as we experience first-hand the struggles that many Dominican Republic residents face. Dr. Murphy earned his Medical Degree from the University of Rochester in New York. He completed a General Surgical Internship, Research Fellowship in Surgery, General Surgical Residency, Orthopedic Surgical Residency-as Chief Resident of Orthopedic Surgery, at the New York City University Medical Center.
